

WELCOME TO OUR LADY IMMACULATE CHURCH

Please help keep us all safe and well - Reminder

Ours is a small church with a diverse congregation and our ability to meet the strict criteria for re-opening is borderline. We have therefore had to apply additional restrictions and apply some restrictions more strictly. None of this is intended to discriminate against anyone but is intended to ensure the safety of those of our parishioners who wish to attend Mass at our church as soon as they feel comfortable to do so. It is therefore possible that attending Mass at Our Lady Immaculate is not possible for everyone but it needs to be borne in mind that the lifting of the obligation to attend Mass on Sunday remains in force.

- Follow instructions from the Stewards at all times
- Read and observe all signs placed in and around the church
- Face coverings obligatory during Mass for those 11 years old and over, no exceptions
- Listen carefully to any new instructions which may be conveyed by Fr. Maurice or the Stewards
- Stay in your allocated seat, you must not move around or get up from your seat during Mass
- All responses by attendees to be made in a normal, not raised voice
- There will be no congregational singing at Mass, although there may be entrance and exit music playing, and no collection of offerings will be taken during the Mass
- Please ensure that you observe **2m** Social Distancing at all times. Our church is too small to allow us to relax this constraint
- Only one individual or household group (couple or adults with children) will be allowed to move through the church at any given time
- Do not leave your seat at the end of Mass until you are called forward by the Steward
- Please use the hand sanitiser product offered by the Stewards at the entrance and exit of the church
- Please leave the church as instructed after Mass and disperse as soon as possible
- There will be no tea/coffee offered after the Mass
- Names and contact details of all those who visit our churches will be retained for 21 days
